- (i) Chemical/hazardous products can enter through
 the eyes. The personal protective equipment
 which is essential in protection of the
 eyes is goggles which will unnimise
 the rish of any damage occurring.
- (ii) Chemical/hazardous products can also enter through the nose and mouth region.

 This rish can be minimized through the use of mouth and nose guards, which don't allow any particles to enter the nose or mouth.
- (iii) Chemical/hazardous products can also enter through the shin. The rish of this occurring can be minimised by waring total body overalls and gloves for effective protection from pazardous materials.
