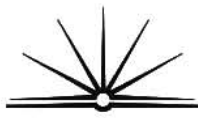




Communication in the workplace is highly important that a clear line of communication is presented from employers and employees.

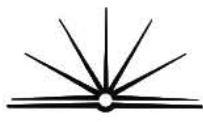
